LIEUTENANT COLONEL SEAN A. ATKINS

Lt Col Sean A. Atkins is Commander of the 21st Student Squadron at Air University's Air Command and Staff College, Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama. He leads 250 active, reserve, guard, sister service, and international officers and civilians throughout a rigorous mid-career graduate program focused on developing airminded joint leaders.

Prior to this, Lt Col Atkins completed a PhD in International Security from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) where he also served as a Project Officer at the Air Force-MIT Artificial Intelligence Accelerator. Before coming to academia, he served as the Director of Operations of the 55th Intelligence Support Squadron where he led a team of 450 officer, enlisted, and contract aviators and ground intelligence and maintenance professionals providing critical intelligence to warfighters and national decision-makers. His national policy experience includes serving as Cyber Policy Advisor in the Office of the Secretary of Defense and establishing and leading the Headquarters Air Force A2 Cyber Capabilities branch. While assigned to the Pentagon, he codeveloped a Presidential Policy Directive on DoD cyber operations, managed key cyber-alliance development, and led the writing of the first Air Force Cyber Operations Strategy.



Lt Col Atkins received his commission through the Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) at the University of Southern California. He is a graduate of the National Security Agency's Junior Officer Cryptologic Career Program and is a qualified RC-135 Information Integration Officer. Lt Col Atkins has deployed multiple times, to include leading Intelligence Community teams in Iraq and Afghanistan, and most recently as Chief of ISR Operations for Operation Inherent Resolve.
