CMSgt Scott R. Devine is the Senior Enlisted Leader of the Air Force Chaplain Corps College. In this capacity he serves as the senior enlisted leader for 14 staff members, working with the Commandant to provide direction and guidance in the development and execution of professional continuing education curriculum to meet the developmental needs of over 2,000 total force chaplains and religious affairs airmen. Additionally, he works with key stakeholders to identify and implement delivery platforms and technologies that enable effective learning, and to incorporate and reinforce key institutional and functional values throughout the continuum of learning.

Chief Devine hails from North Little Rock, Arkansas and entered the Air Force in January 2001. He served in the Aircraft Structural Maintenance career field for seven years working on all fighter jets to include painting and corrosion control. Additionally, Chief Devine worked as an Aircraft Battle Damage Repair and Crash Damage Repair Craftsman. Furthermore, he has deployed four times in support of Operations Southern Watch, Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, New Dawn, Freedom's Sentinel, and Inherent Resolve. CMSgt Devine has served in the Religious Affairs career field since 2007. He has served multiple assignments as the Superintendent of Religious Affairs and Manager of Plans and Programs for the Air Force Chief of Chaplains office, developing Air Force policy and procedures. Prior to his current assignment, CMSgt Devine was the Space Force Religious Affairs Senior Enlisted Leader.
