

There numerous CBTs that Holm Center provides to help you meet the responsibilities at your unit and gain continuing education credit.

The DoD Information Assurance Course is a mandatory annual training that must be completed to grant and retain access to DoD systems including WINGS and AJFROTC email.

There are 4 Distance Learning Computer-based Training courses designed to enhance teaching skills, earn you continuing education credit, up to 12 college credit hours towards undergraduate/graduate degree, and possibly satisfy some state board of education teaching licensure requirements. The courses are transferrable and regionally accredited through the Higher Learning Commission (HLC). Additionally, they can be used to qualify for AFJROTC Advanced Certification and are of no cost to you.

In the future you will also find Recurring Continuing Education courses here. These course will be required to maintain certification.

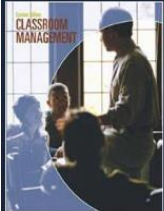

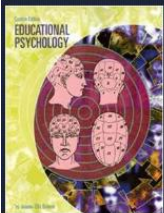

There are 4 courses in Distance Learning module. The courses are:



Classroom Management -- This course will provide Junior ROTC instructors with the information needed to focus on the core principles and practices of classroom management. This course blends a humanistic, competency-based approach with an applied, research-based, behavior management approach to provide instructors with the best current thinking on effective classroom management.



Education Psychology -- This course explains the cognitive, linguistic, personal, social, and moral development of individuals as well as individual and group differences. The course also describes behaviorist and social cognitive views of learning, intrinsic and extrinsic motivation, and informal and formal assessments.
