Colonel Stephen T. Sanders is the Director, Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps, Maxwell Air Force Base, AL. He is responsible for the Air Force's high school citizenship training program comprised of about 125,000 students and 1,900 instructors at approximately 880 high schools worldwide. Colonel Sanders directs staff initiatives and policy to implement the world's largest and most comprehensive aerospace science education program.

Colonel Sanders received his commission from the United States Air Force Academy in 1995 and has held a variety of leadership positions primarily in aircraft maintenance and logistics support. He has led multiple operational deployments in support of Operations ENDURING and IRAQI FREEDOM. Prior to his current position Colonel Sanders served as the Vice Commander of the Thomas N. Barnes Center for Enlisted Education.
