CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT JOFRED AVILES

CMSgt Jofred Aviles serves as an instructor for the Chief Master Sergeant Leadership Course (CLC) at Maxwell AFB Gunter Annex, Alabama. As a facilitator for the Air Force's premier level of Enlisted Professional Military Education, he prepares over 750 Total Force Chief Master Sergeants annually to bridge the gap between strategic vision and tactical execution. Beyond the classroom, CMSgt Aviles advises the Commandant on instructional standards and policy, shaping the academic vision for the future force. Additionally, he bolsters total force readiness by instructing at the Air Force Reserve Command's Chief Orientation Course, graduating 200 newly promoted Chiefs each year.

Chief Aviles enlisted in the Air Force in June 2006 as a Health Services Management Apprentice. His career spans diverse leadership roles across Health Services, Aerospace Medicine, and Special Operations Support. Notably, he served as the Air Force Reserve Command's Medical Staff Manager, directing credentialing and privileging for 2,106 providers across 63 units. Concurrently, as a MAJCOM Functional Manager, he guided 1,600 personnel across four enlisted AFSCs. Furthermore, Chief Aviles has deployed in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, FREEDOM'S SENTINEL, INHERENT RESOLVE, and DELIBERATIVE RESOLVE.



Prior to his current assignment, Chief Aviles served as the Group Senior Enlisted Leader for Headquarters, Readiness and Integration Organization at Buckley Space Force Base, Colorado. In this capacity, he directed the readiness, morale, and professional development of 7,800 Individual Mobilization Augmentees (IMAs) and Participating Individual Ready Reservists. He provided strategic oversight for 143 staff members and implemented personnel policies across 53 organizations, including all Major Commands and Combatant Commands, ensuring the delivery of combat-ready Airmen to the active component.
