

CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT ANDREW D. "ANDY" SOTAK

CMSgt Andrew D. Sotak is the Commandant at the Chief Leadership Academy, Maxwell Air Force Base - Gunter Annex, Alabama. In this role, he leads a team of 13 highly selective Profession of Arms Instructors charged with cultivating the development of Air Force Chief Master Sergeants across the Air Force enterprise. Chief Sotak entered the Air Force in July 2002 as an Aerospace Propulsion Apprentice. Throughout his career, Chief Sotak has primarily worked Flightline, JEIM, Isochronal, Test-Cell, Test and Evaluation, and Aircraft Production sections. As a maintenance SME he supported multiple weapon systems including the C-5, E-3, E-8, F-16, HH-60, and KC-135 aircraft.

As an Air Advisor dual-hatting as the Contract Officer Representative serving in Iraq, he supported the stand-up and sustainment of the Iraqi Army Aviation Command's MI-171, Attack Bell-407 and Huey-II helicopter maintenance capabilities. Chief Sotak has deployed multiple times in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM, NEW DAWN, INHERENT RESOLVE, and FREEDOM'S SENTINEL. Prior to assuming his current position, Chief Sotak served as the Senior Enlisted Leader, 718th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, Kadena Air Base, Okinawa Japan. He led 530 active-duty personnel where he was responsible for the combat readiness and sortic generation of 15 KC-135s, nine HH-60s, and two low-density/high-demand E-3



platforms providing theater-wide aerial refueling, combat search and rescue, and direct airborne command and control, with long-range surveillance mission operations ensuring a free and open Indo-Pacific.
