

Three Slides

Purpose

Three Slides is a creative way to introduce new members to a unit and/or learn more about coworkers through pictures/stories. Recommend showing one a week during a staff meeting as new people arrive or a Friday afternoon gathering and present all of them as a teambuilder.

Description

Everyone has a story. This is an opportunity for everyone to have their moment to share details about their life outside of work. The idea is to share photos within a 3-slide format to showcase a potential other side of a person that is not always visible. This activity will increase involvement, builds trust, and touches a innate need to be valued and appreciated among coworkers and colleagues.

The 3-slides showcase each person's testimony and story about who they are, what they value and who they want to be. Its deliberately engineered success! Nobody can go wrong with what they put on their own slides.

Execution

- Slide 1: Use pictures to describe "Who is most dearest to You"
- Slide 2: Use pictures to explain "Where I grew up" and/or are "Where do they most call home."
- Slide 3: Use pictures to answer "Where I want to be in 5-8 years"
- 5-10 minutes to present their story
