Lt Col Randy S. Cicale is the Commander, 22nd Training Support Squadron, Officer Training School, Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama. He reports directly to the Commandant of the Officer Training School regarding the training and commissioning of approximately 3,000 Air Force Active Duty, Reserve, and Air National Guard officers annually. Additionally, he is responsible for a \$75 million world-class campus, including numerous field training sites.

Lt Col Cicale is a 2006 graduate of the Rochester Institute of Technology. Upon entering active duty, he performed a wide range of tasks under the lonospheric Effects and Hazards section of the Space Vehicles Directorate at the Air Force Research Laboratory. He has led various initiatives at the 624 Operations Center that revolutionized how offensive and defensive cyber assets were organized and tasked. He led two



deployment teams in Space Electronic Warfare and later led the development of the newly established U.S. Space Force's first Program Objective Memorandum 5-year \$90B+ budget. Prior to his current assignment, he was the Protection Capability Program Manager at the National Reconnaissance Office leading end-to-end systems engineering for the protection of national space assets.
