LIEUTENANT COLONEL CHRISTOPHER J. ANGLIN

Lieutenant Colonel Christopher J. Anglin serves as the Director of the Operations Directorate, Squadron Officer School, Air University, Maxwell AFB, Alabama. The Operations Directorate is responsible for scheduling, registrar functions and operations coordination for the Air Force's largest Officer Professional Military Education. He is responsible for ensuring 4,200 students attend Squadron Officer School annually, including Department of the Air Force civilians and International Officers.

Lieutenant Colonel Anglin enlisted in the Air Force as an Inventory Management Specialist and later re-trained into the Contracts Management career field. He held various positions at Tinker AFB; Keflavik AB, Iceland; Elmendorf AFB and Whiteman AFB. Lieutenant Colonel Anglin received his commission through Officer Training School in 2001. He was assigned to the 3rd Contracting Squadron, Elmendorf AFB, Alaska. During this period, Lieutenant Colonel Anglin deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Lieutenant Colonel Anglin then served as Executive Officer and Support Flight Commander of the 360th Recruiting Group, Hanscom AFB, Massachusetts.

Lieutenant Colonel Anglin was board selected to attend the Strategic Sourcing Masters of Business Administration program at the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California. Upon graduation, Lieutenant Colonel Anglin served as Contracting Branch Chief, Air Force Logistics Management Agency, Maxwell AFB, Gunter Annex, Alabama. During this period, Lieutenant Colonel Anglin deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. The Air Force Logistics Management Agency closed its doors and Lieutenant Colonel Anglin moved to Hanscom AFB to serve as Branch Chief, Space and Aerial Networks Division. Lieutenant Colonel Anglin was then competitively selected to command Detachment 1, 21st Contracting Squadron at the US Embassy in Copenhagen, Denmark. Next, he was the Deputy Chief of the Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) Contracting Division, Air Force Nuclear Weapons Center, Hill AFB, Utah. Lieutenant Colonel Anglin was again competitively selected to command and it was at the 379th Expeditionary Contracting Squadron at Al Udeid AB, Qatar. Previously, he was the Deputy Director of Contracting at Air Force Installation Contracting Agency, Operating Location Air Combat Command (OL-ACC), Joint Base Langley-Eustis, VA.

Lieutenant Colonel Anglin is from Kansas City, Missouri and is an APDP Level III Contracting Officer. He is married to Joanne and they have seven children.
