“Understanding the Adversary: Strategic Empathy and Perspective Taking in National Security”
by Allison Abbe, in *Parameters*



WHO: All national security practitioners (and educators!)

WHAT: Dr. Allison Abbe, Professor of Organizational Studies at the U.S. Army War College, makes the argument that perspective taking is essential to analysis and decision-making in national security. She recommends “four ways strategists and practitioners can enhance their ability to gain insight into adversaries.”

WHY: This article builds on extant literature around the concept of strategic empathy and expands our understanding of how perspective-taking is a more focused area for leadership development. This is a worthwhile discussion for all military education stakeholders, especially those working in leader and leadership development.
