Teaching Essentials Course (TEC) -

The TEC team (formerly FEC) has been working on a variety of delivery formats for the Teaching Essentials Course.

The TEC introduces teaching as a profession with synchronous and asynchronous lessons designed to emphasize student-centered learning.



Synchronous. The synchronous option is conducted via Teams and allows organizations to schedule individual lessons or micro-lessons. Standard lessons cover each topic in depth. Micro-lessons are 30 minutes and focus on a single concept. Their short duration is an antidote to virtual fatigue. Activities common to both lessons emphasize practical application and include breakout rooms, live chats, and live-streaming presentations. Organizations may select lessons as needed for a customizable approach to faculty development.

Hybrid. Face-to-face lessons are a part of our hybrid option. Each face-to-face lesson culminates with an online activity to reinforce concepts and provide practice for direct application. The hybrid option is available as a ten-day course and includes 25 lessons.

Asynchronous. Currently under development, the asynchronous self-paced option uses Canvas to provide self-guided lessons, pre-recorded video content, lecture notes, activities, and discussion boards. Students can take any or all lessons and in any order. Recommended lesson sequencing will be provided.

Regardless of delivery format, instructors will be available as needed. Contact the TLC for more information.
