Volunteer Faculty Tutors Needed! -In the new academic year, the Writing Lab has been busier than ever, conducting 260 student appointments in August and September alone. With no sign of slowing down, we're looking to grow our team with more volunteer faculty tutors. Faculty tutors are essential to the mission of the Writing Lab in meeting the high demand for student support, and tutoring is a rewarding way to fulfill AU's faculty service expectations. Tutors meet with students in 45-minute appointments either in person or over Teams (by tutor preference), and scheduling is flexible: faculty tutors typically offer one to six appointments per week during regular work hours. In appointments, tutors discuss students' work with them, providing feedback,

strategies, and tools students can use to strengthen not only the assignment but also their writing skills overall. The Writing Lab supports all officer.
