Office 365 – O365 is coming to the .MIL environment. All the O365 tricks you've been learning in the Air University pilot version of O365 can now be applied to what is currently being stood up for all USAF .MIL users! To begin using OneDrive (1TB cloud storage!) on your NIPR PC, go to https://usaf-my.dps.mil, access instructions (view NOTES pages), or contact your local Cyber Security Liaison (CSL). NOTE: You may need to refresh your screen a time or two.

Learning Tech Research – Stop by the TLC to learn about the Classroom Interactive Digital Display System (CIDDS) as a core tool for the classroom. It's a very large multi-touch screen with one or more computers to provide instructors or students with a great presentation capability.
